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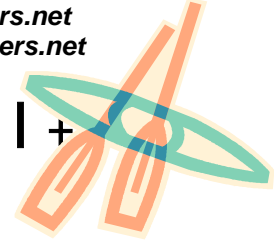

Full-Day Trip Information:

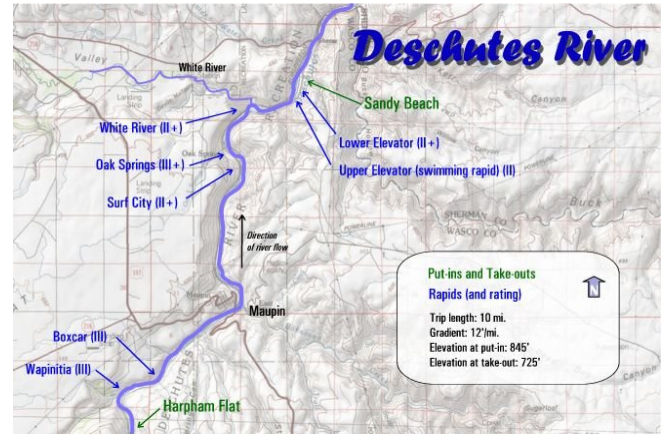


Thank you for reserving your trip with River Drifters. We look forward to providing you with the finest river trip possible. Please read the following information regarding your trip and if you have any questions or concerns feel free to call us at 1-800-972-0430.

The section of the Deschutes River that we run on our full day trip covers 15 river miles on the Lower Deschutes, and is one of the most popular summer river runs in Oregon. During your trip you will travel through a beautiful desert canyon filled with sage brush, osprey, incredible basalt rock formations and plenty of exciting rapids. The Deschutes River is great for all kinds of rafters from first-timers to seasoned paddlers, however, our minimum age is 4 years old. Please let us know if you have any health concerns prior to your trip.


Trip Itinerary*

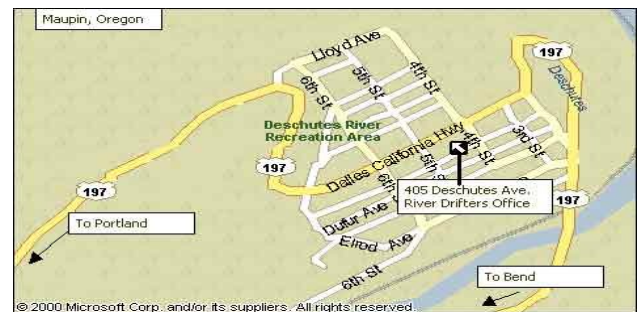
- 9:45 arrive in Maupin and sign in
- 10:15 depart for Harpham Flats (put-in)
- 10:30 start rafting!!!!
- 12:15 BBQ lunch, yum!
- 2:00 Arrive at White River 
- 2:45 Arrive at swimmers rapid
- 3:30 Arrive at Sandy Beach take-out
- 4:00 Arrive back at the River Drifter's shop to see photos and change clothes.



River Drifters will provide a wetsuit and splash jacket if needed. However, if anyone in your group gets cold easily make sure to bring along an extra layer of capilene, poly pro, fleece, or long sleeve underwear type of shirt for their upper body. No cotton! Even though the air may be warm the water is in the mid 50s. Nobody has fun when they are cold and we want everyone to have a good time!

We also suggest that you bring the following items to ensure your comfort:

- ___ Shorts and T-shirt (quick drying/non-cotton) or bathing suit
- ___ Long Sleeve Shirts and hat for sun protection
- ___ Old Tennis shoes or sandals
- ___ Sunglasses with strap 
- ___ Waterproof Sunscreen
- ___ Change of clothes for the drive home!

Alternate Route:

Great route if you're coming from the southern Portland area. Travel east on Hwy. 26 through government camp. After you enter the Warm Springs Indian Reservation turn left onto Hwy. 216 towards Maubin. Travel 30 miles and turn right onto Hwy. 197 and Maubin and look for our shop on the right next to the Rainbow Tavern.



Directions from Tri-Cities Area:

Drive south on I-82 and take exit 179 onto I-84 going west. Travel 93 miles to The Dalles and then take exit 87 going south on Hwy. 197. Travel 40 miles to Maubin and look for our shop on the right, next to the Rainbow Tavern.

Approximate Travel Times

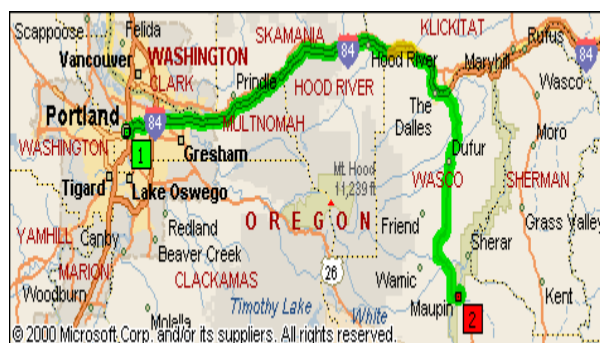
Portland/Vancouver Area: 2 hrs.

Portland/Vancouver:

Take I-205 going north, then I-84 going east. Take exit 87 and turn right going south on Hwy. 197. Drive 40 miles south until you reach Maubin. Our shop is on the right next to the Rainbow Tavern.



Directions from Central Oregon:

Head north on Hwy. 97. Travel through Madras and veer RIGHT (immediately after McDonalds) following Hwy. 97 & Hwy. 26. Travel 25 miles to Hwy. 197, veer left and travel 22 miles to Maubin. Follow the highway across the bridge and up the hill. Our shop is on the left next to the Rainbow Tavern.
