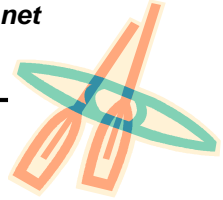

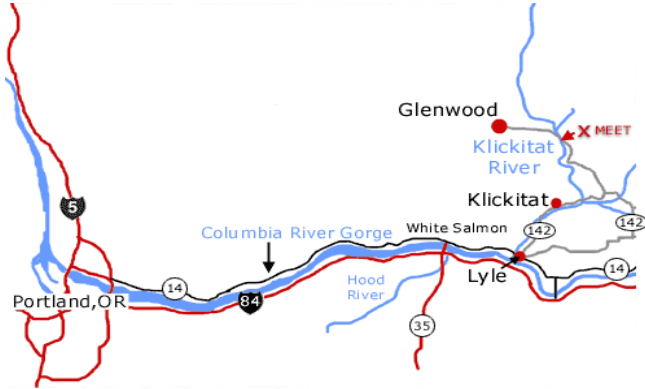


Trip Information:

Thank you for reserving your trip with River Drifters. We look forward to providing you with the finest river trip possible. Please read the following information regarding your trip and if you have any questions or concerns feel free to call us at 1-800-972-0430.

The Klickitat River drains out of the Goat Rock Wilderness and provides an exciting, action packed run through some beautiful scenery. You will begin your day rafting through a beautiful secluded gorge packed full with back to back Class I I I rapids and then continue along watching as the scenery changes into desert canyon. Wildlife is abundant so keep your eyes peeled for deer, elk, osprey, and even the occasional spotted owl during your 17-21 mile trip.

Restrictions:
The Klickitat River is great for adventurous first-timers to seasoned paddlers, however we do have some age restrictions:
Minimum Age (March-May): 14
Minimum Age (May-August): 10
Please let us know if you have any health concerns prior to the trip.



River Drifters will provide a wetsuit, paddle jacket, and helmet. If anyone in your group gets cold easily make sure to bring along an extra layer of capiline, poly pro, fleece, or long sleeve underwear type of shirt for their upper body. No cotton! Even though the air may be warm the water is in the mid 40s. Nobody has fun when they are cold and we want everyone to have a good time!

Directions from Portland/Vancouver Area:
 Travel on I-84 going East to Hood River; take Exit #64 to White Salmon; cross the Columbia River and take a LEFT at the light. Continue west on highway 14 for 1.2 miles, just before the bridge take a right on Alt. Hwy. 141. Follow sign to Trout Lake and Hwy. 141 (1.4 miles); at the stop sign turn LEFT onto Hwy. 141. Continue to **BZ Corners** and turn right; just before The Logs Restaurant. Travel Northeast towards **Glenwood**; roughly 15 miles (this road has many turns, follow signs towards Glenwood). Once in Glenwood turn RIGHT; travel roughly 15+ miles EAST until you reach a campground on your right marked Liedl Campground just after the only bridge that crosses

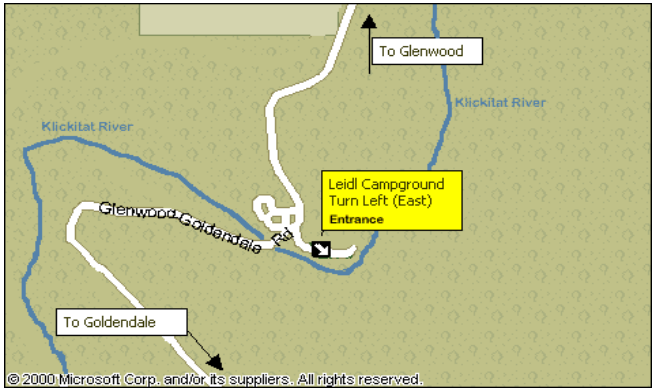
